State Primary Election, August 9, 2022
State General Election, November 8, 2022

Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 203B.05 and 203B.081, in addition to the offices of the Auditor-Treasurer at the Cass County Courthouse in Walker Minnesota, the following locations are designated for absentee voting in Cass County for 2022 state elections:

Absentee voting begins 46 days before elections: June 24th for Primary and September 23rd for General Election. The absentee ballot locations will issue ballots until 5:00 p.m. the Monday before Election Day.
